 - **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Digital Dollar Pilot5 Prevention Act".

1 SEC. 2. CENTRAL BANK DIGITAL CURRENCY.

2 The Federal Reserve Act (12 U.S.C. 221 et seq.) is
3 amended by inserting after section 16 the following:

4 "SEC. 16A. CENTRAL BANK DIGITAL CURRENCY.

"(a) IN GENERAL.—Unless authorized by an Act of 5 Congress enacted after the date of the enactment of this 6 7 Act, the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve Sys-8 tem and the Federal reserve banks may not establish, 9 carry out, or approve a program intended to test the practicability of issuing a central bank digital currency, includ-10 ing by partnering or coordinating with a private sector en-11 tity to carry out such a program. 12

13 "(b) CENTRAL BANK DIGITAL CURRENCY DE14 FINED.—In this section, the term 'central bank digital
15 currency' means a form of digital money or monetary
16 value, denominated in the national unit of account, that
17 is a direct liability of the Federal Reserve.".
